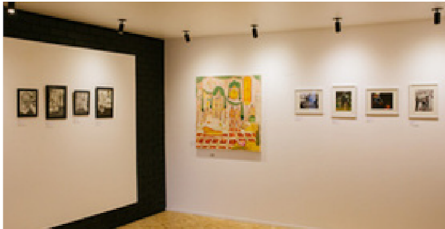

An independent art gallery run by creatives, showcasing traditional gallery shows and more.

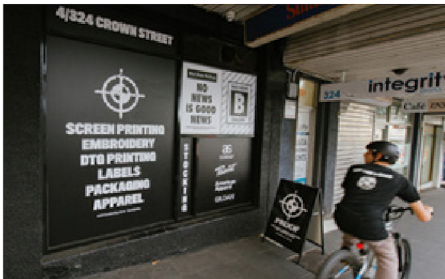

A creative print studio where anything is possible, printing t-shirts, totes, posters, and more.

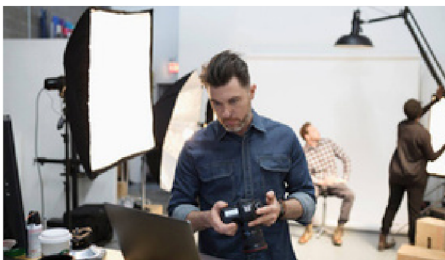


## TAFE NSW - Wollongong West

Providing courses in Photography and Visual Arts, students have access to studio spaces and a darkroom.

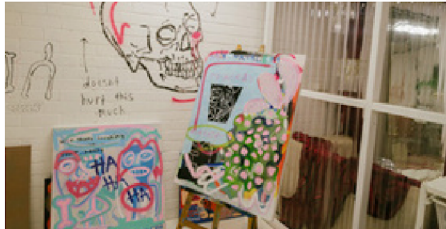


## The Heart

A dynamic and beautiful warehouse space, now transformed into a multi-room studio for local creatives.

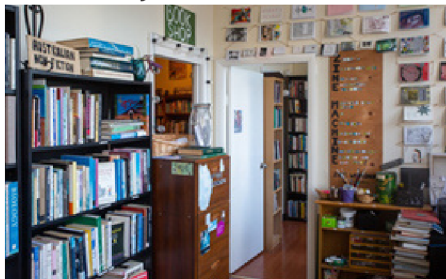


## Society City

Volunteer-run secondhand bookshop and community space for arts, workshops, events and co-working.

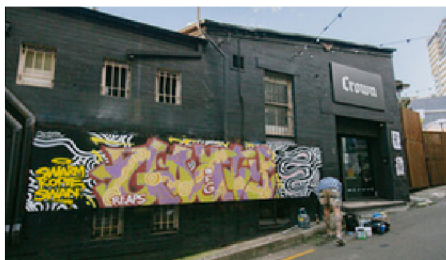


## Crown Art and Design

A community ceramic studio that offers classes and courses from handbuilding to wheel-throwing.

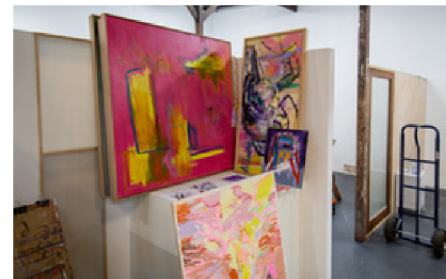


## 130 Art Studios

The Egg & Dart gallery showcases regular exhibitions, and offers custom design framing, art consultation, and installations.

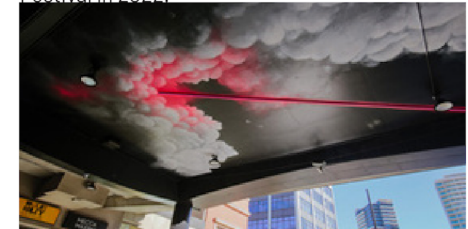

The ever changing legal graffiti wall, where people can share their work and socialise in a shared space.

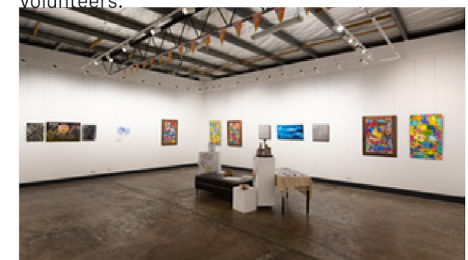

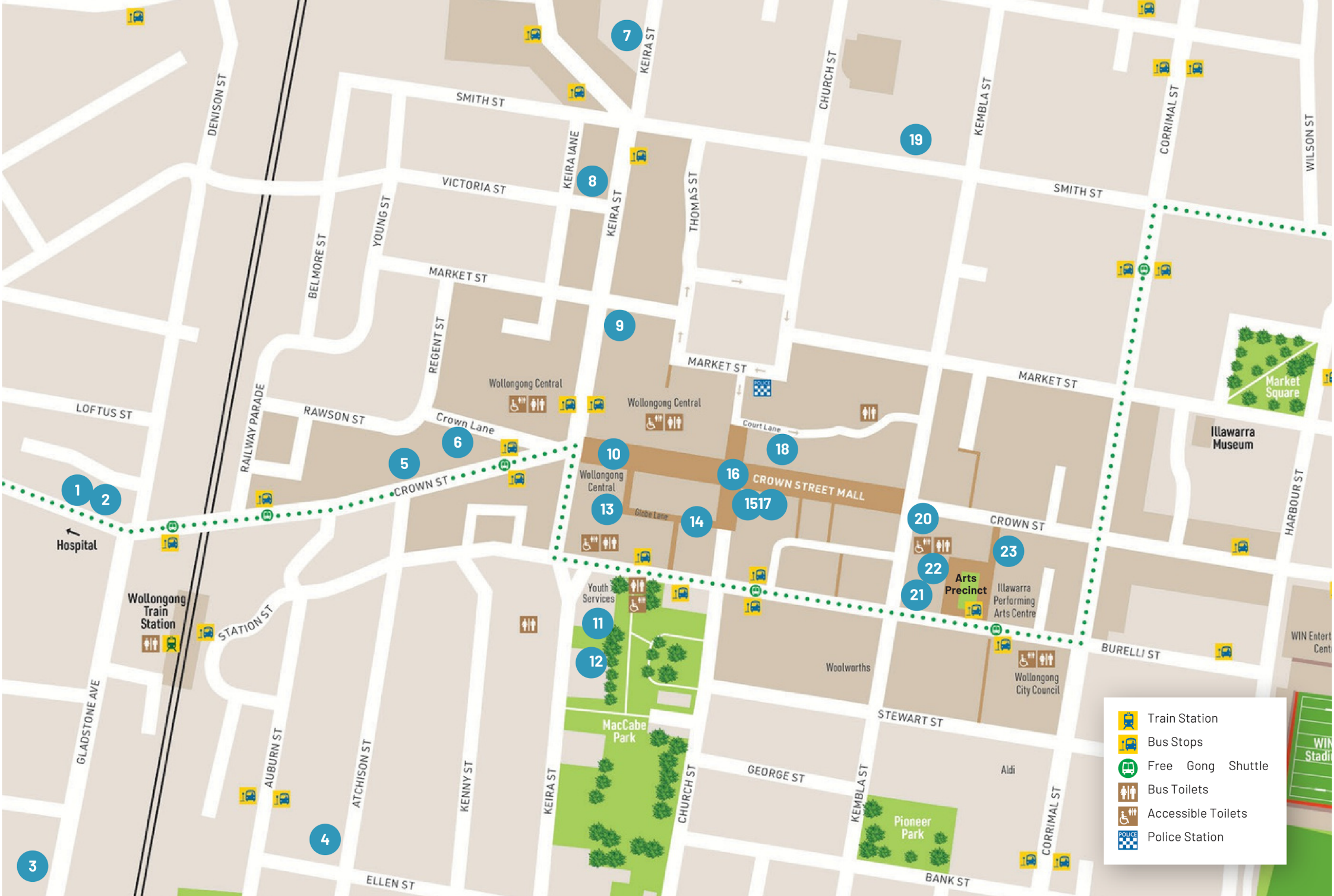

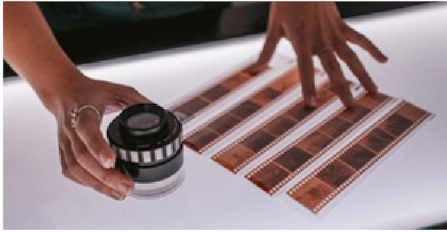

Wonderwalls is a street art festival launched in 2012 and includes over 50 artworks in the CBD, including this mural by Smug.

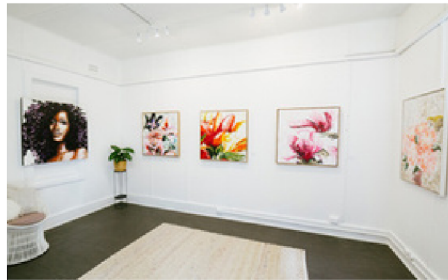

A pedestrian laneway with a series of regularly changing art light box installations.

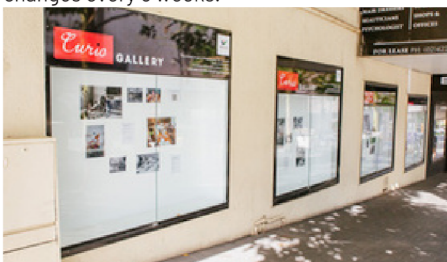

The Curio Gallery is a place for temporary exhibitions for local emerging artists, and changes every 6 weeks.

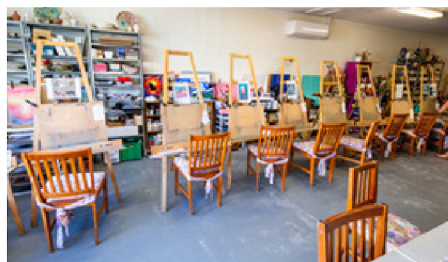
